## **Financial Partnership Update**

Recently I had a meeting with our personnel advisor about our Wycliffe status. Krista and I are currently at 93% of our support, lacking only \$400 per month. We need to receive 100% of the needed funds by November 30, 2006, or we will be asked to resign. Wycliffe has a policy about how long people take to raise support, and we are approaching the critical deadline. We know that the Lord wants us to continue in this ministry, evidenced by Him leading us to move to JAARS, and many confirming details resulting from that decision.

Krista and I are thankful for those of you who have committed to be financial partners, thereby helping us narrow the gap toward having all the funds we need! Over the last year, people and churches have committed an additional \$500 per month in support and we are getting very close to reaching our goal. Just think – with additional churches, individuals or families each committing either \$25, \$50 or \$100 monthly we could be at full support!

Our home in Orlando has been on the market for three months. Last month we changed realtors to achieve a more aggressive marketing strategy and we reduced the price. Lately we have had a number of home showings, and we feel it won't be long until we have a buyer. When our house in Orlando sells, we will actively pursue buying a home in N. Carolina.

## **Family News — The Move Begins...**

As the new school year approached, we had to make a tough decision about whether to start Nicholas and Amanda at school in Orlando, or to move to temporary housing in N. Carolina so they could begin school there. We decided to make the move, in a step of faith that the Lord would provide our additional financial needs until our home in Orlando sells. Krista, Nick, and Amanda are now living in a small low cost apartment at the JAARS

center in N. Carolina, and the kids have begun school in that area. It's beginning to feel like home for them, and they are adjusting to all the differences between urban Orlando and the rural Carolinas. Our temporary address and phone number at the apartment are listed above in small print.

I am staying mainly in Orlando to maintain our house until it sells. I am continuing to pack for our move, and also following through on raising the remaining support for our ministry. Once every few weeks I will make the eight-hour drive to N. Carolina to see Krista and the kids.

I am excited to begin my impending job in Information Technology Services at JAARS, using technology to help with the worldwide task of Bible translation! The focus of this work at JAARS is somewhat more global than what I have been involved with in Orlando.
